The ALKOOMI vineyards and winery of Merv & Judy Lange are located in the Frankland River district of Western Australia's Great Southern wine region. Since climatic conditions are similar to those of Bordeaux in France, it is not surprising that this region produces some of the best wines made in Australia. The name ALKOOMI is taken from local aboriginal dialect and means 'a place we chose'. The logo represents a distinctive Australian plant which grows in the area.

## 2006 RIESLING

The cool climate and gravelly loam soils of the Frankland River region in the South of Western Australia are well suited to the production of intense and elegantly structured wines. This wine was picked in pristine condition and at an ideal Baumé of 12°. The wine was made entirely from free run juice and contains no pressings. It was fermented cold in steel with aromatic yeast and bottled early for freshness.

Growing Region:	Frankland River, Western Australia
Vintage:	A cool, cloudy spring, followed by a cool summer, led to a very late vintage.
Colour:	Pale straw with green tinges.
Bouquet:	Lifted aromatics with hints of citrus blossom, jasmine and green apple.
Palate:	Fresh, rich and elegant with lime, citrus and mineral flavours nicely balanced by fine natural acidity.
Cellaring:	Drinking well now, this wine will cellar well for up to ten years.
Suggestions:	Excellent as an aperitif or with delicate seafood dishes.
Alcohol:	12.5%
